



## **Former Liverpool FC stars to start Vitality Liverpool Half Marathon**

Liverpool FC legends Ian Rush and Robbie Fowler have been confirmed as official starters of this Sunday's Vitality Liverpool Half Marathon.

The two strikers will sound the horn as over 5,000 runners cross the start line in front of the Pier Head Liverpool at 9.00am, on Sunday April 2.

Ian Rush made 660 appearances for the Reds, scoring 346 goals, with Robbie Fowler appearing in 369 games scoring 183 goals – naturally both are considered legends of Liverpool FC.

A wealth of runners will be raising vital finds for the Liverpool FC Foundation – the Club's official charity.

Sunday's race is part of the national Vitality Run Series.

Neville Koopowitz, CEO of Vitality, said: "We are delighted that Robbie and Ian will be our race starters. With their involvement and the generous support of the Liverpool crowds, it promises to be a great day for runners and all those involved with the run."
